Accommodation






Your Malvern experience is also about where you live: the people you meet, the relationships you build and the neighbourhoods you explore.

We offer two types of accommodation, staying at a host's house (homestay) or living in university accommodation (residence).





Homestay

Homestay is a chance to experience local life and practise your English, to learn things from your host that you would probably never learn in the classroom. Our hosts are a reflection of the cities they live in: where they live, who they live with, the type of building they live in, the jobs they do and how they spend their free time. But all of them are curious about international students and other cultures, and enthusiastic about sharing their lives and interests with others. All hosts are inspected in line with British Council accreditation criteria and hosts for under-18s are police (DBS) checked.

They're also perfectly located, just 20-30 minutes walk from Malvern House Manchester.

Main London Residence

Sterling Court is located in Zone 4, minutes away from Wembley Stadium. The residence offers excellent value with a range of recently refurbished ensuite rooms. 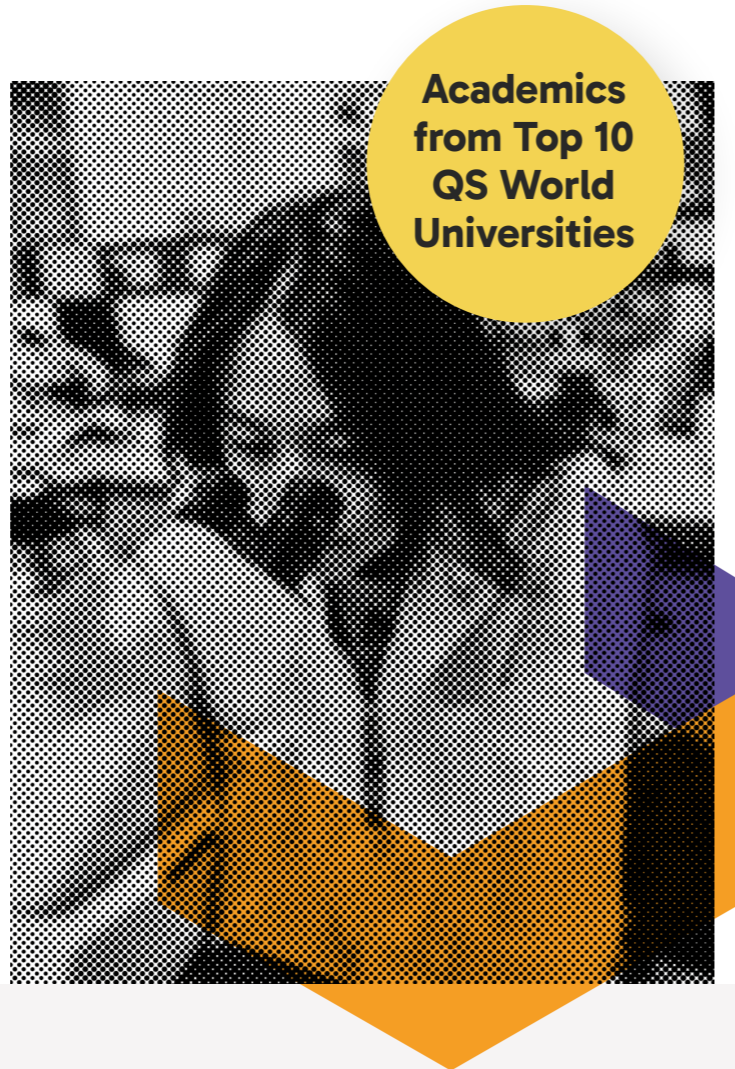

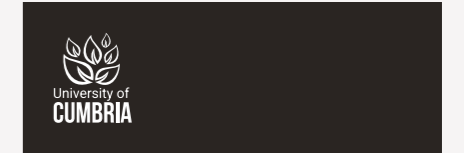

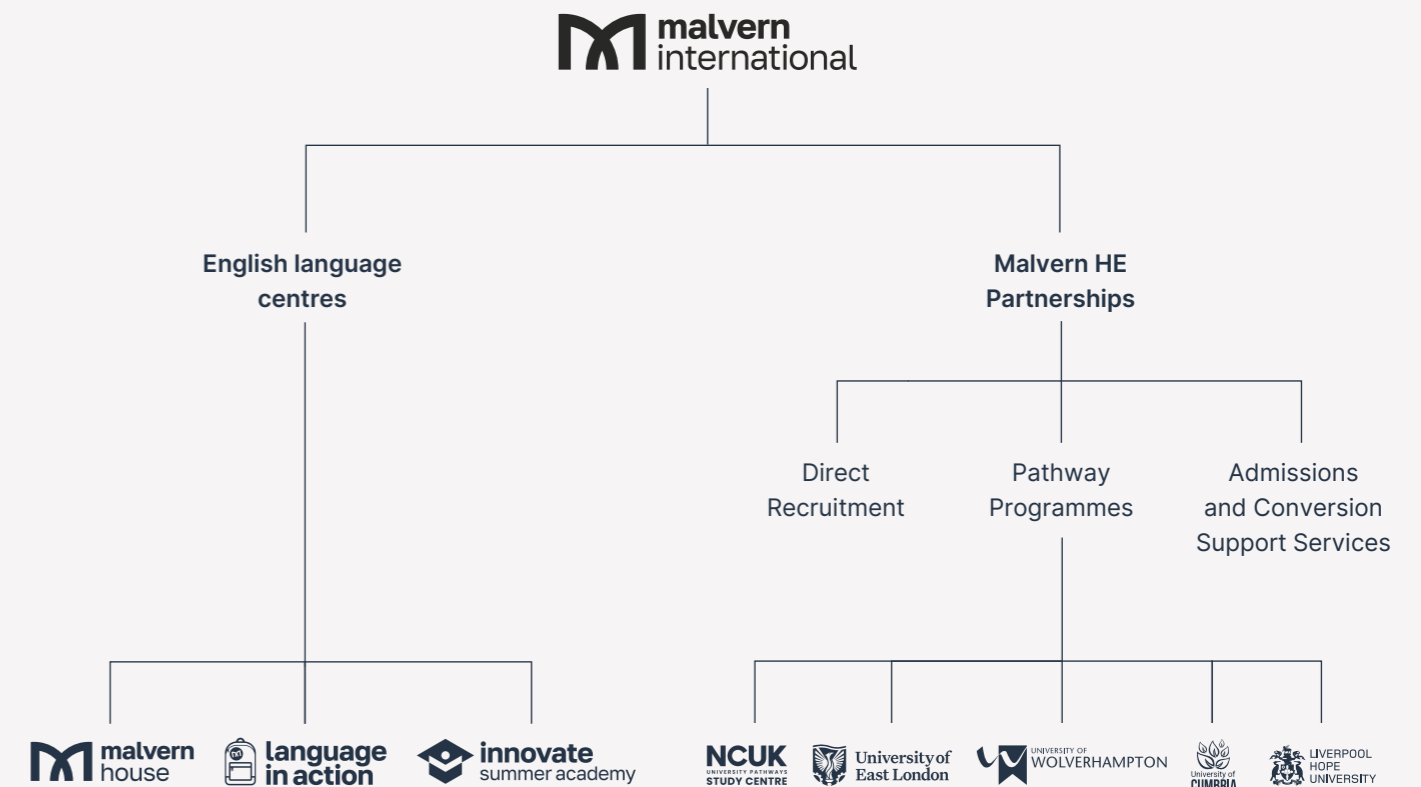
